



RISKS REMINDER

Your audiologist has achieved competency in wax removal we do perform procedures with the upmost care. However, there are low-level risks to microsuction, irrigation and manual wax removal techniques each time it is performed. You should be aware of the following risks that are associated with the procedures:

1. Agitation of the ear canal, causing possible damage or infection to the skin of the ear canal or eardrum during the procedure. *Please note – if you are on blood thinners there is an increased risk of bleeding.*
2. Temporary tinnitus or aggravation of tinnitus.
3. Temporary dizziness and discomfort.
