

RISKS REMINDER

Your audiologist has achieved competency in wax removal we do perform procedures with the upmost care. However, there are low-level risks to microsuction, irrigation and manual wax removal techniques each time it is performed. You should be aware of the following risks that are associated with the procedures:

- 1. Agitation of the ear canal, causing possible damage or infection to the skin of the ear canal or eardrum during the procedure. Please note if you are on blood thinners there is an increased risk of bleeding.
- 2. Temporary tinnitus or aggravation of tinnitus.
- 3. Temporary dizziness and discomfort.
